SEEKING SAFETY with New Clients

TO OCCUR DURING ASSESSMENT PHASE; 6th WEEK OF TREATMENT; SIX MONTH; ANNUAL

ASSESSMENT PHASE (NEW clients--ages 12 through 20 years--assigned to you):

- First face to face session with the client: Administer the **CRAFFT Screening Interview** (If you administer the paper version, please be sure to input it into EHR)
- If the client has given two or more YES responses on the CRAFFT = At Risk
- If the client has been identified to be *At Risk* on the CRAFFT then administer the **SACS-Part B** (Substance Abuse and Choices Scale)
 - The SACS-Part B needs to be administered/hand scored within the next 30 days
- After the SACS-Part B has been administered: Enter CRAFFT and SACS-Part B results into Survey Monkey within 3 business days
- o Document administration of the SACS-Part B within your Assessment session progress note
- Survey Monkey
 - After both the CRAFFT and the SACS-Part B have been administered and scored log onto the Survey Monkey website to record results

- ➢ The Care Plan
 - o Include Seeking Safety as one of the Interventions in the Care Plan with the Service Type being "MHS Individual"
 - The Seeking Safety intervention needs to be included in the *Objectives*
 - Once the Care Plan is signed, begin using the Seeking Safety intervention!

6th WEEK OF TREATMENT (from the date the Care Plan was signed):

- > Review the Seeking Safety Manual, especially Chapter 2, prior to beginning the Seeking Safety Intervention
- > Be flexible with the Seeking Safety intervention and feel free to choose a topic that would best fit your client.
 - Continue with the Seeking Safety intervention for <u>6 weeks</u>. **Not six sessions!!**
 - At the 6^{TH} week, re-administer the SACS-Part B
 - o The hand scored results of the SACS-Part B need to entered into Survey Monkey within 3 business days
 - The re-administration of the SACS-Part B needs to be billed/documented as an Assessment Service

 - o After the re-administration of the SACS-Part B, log on to Survey Monkey to record results
- If the client's case is closed prior to the re-administration of the SACS-Part B at week 6, please log in and record the discharge on to Survey Monkey: <u>https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/ZGN6FHB</u>

SIX MONTHS (from the date the Care Plan was signed):

- Re-administer the SACS-Part B again at the 6 month time frame and follow the same steps on Survey Monkey as you did with the 6 week administration
 - o An Assessment Service can be billed/documented again

ANNUAL (from the date the Care Plan was signed):

- At the *Annual* time frame
 - Re-Administer the CRAFFT as per usual protocol
 - o If the client score on the CRAFFT places them At Risk, then re-administer the SACS-
 - Part B and follow the same procedures as before
