








9-1-1 ambulance transport volume has been trending up over the last serveral days. Volume continues to average about 10-15% below normal (pre-COVID) levels (Updated 03/24/21).



Non-emergency ambulance transports have remained steady over the last few weeks. Transport volume continues to average about 30-35% below normal (pre-COVID) levels overall (Updated 03/24/21).



Primary Impressions of Cold/Flu/ILI by 9-1-1 EMS have stabalized and are near normal baseline levels for this time of year. (Updated 03/24/21).



- Ambulance Patient Offload Time (APOT) is defined as the time the ambulance arrives at the receiving destination (wheels stop) to the time that the ambulance crew physically transfers the patient to the ED gurney. Last 24 hours: Current Average APOT is: 12m46s / Current 90th Percentile APOT is: 28m16s
- Six (6) ERCs had APOT times greater than thirty (30) minutes.
- Three (3) ERCs had APOT times greater than sixty (60) minutes.

The chart below displays a daily trend over the <u>last 30 days</u>.



#### **MOBILE FIELD HOSPITALS (MFHs)**

- MFHs are capable of expanding current hospital capacity by adding additional patient beds.
- They are large heavy duty canvas tents with hard flooring and temperature controlled units.
- They can be configured in a myriad of footprints and sizes (i.e. 25-200 patient bed).
- OCEMS has a total of 8 trailers to support at minimum, 200 patient beds.
- CDPH is primed and ready to provide hospitals a waiver to allow emergency use of these MFHs.
  - o Hospitals who have self-identified in receiving a MFH include:
    - **Output** UCI (50 patient bed) currently used for patient care activities
    - Fountain Valley (25 patient bed) converting to community vaccination clinic facility
    - Los Alamitos (25 patient bed) demobilized
    - Saint Jude (50 patient bed) demobilizing the week of March 22.
