Emergency Department Disposition	eOutcome.01	The known disposition of the patient from the Emergency Department (ED).	Disposition here means final action, e.g. Discharged, Admitted, Left AMA, Expired, etc.	Required
Hospital Disposition	eOutcome.02	The known disposition of the patient from the hospital, if admitted.	Only applies to patients that were admitted to an in-patient service or observation.	Required
<i>Not Applicable</i>	eOutcome.03	The Type of External Report or Record associated with the Report/ID Number.	Hard-coded into the OC-MEDS Hospital Hub. Differentiates the three eOutcome.04 fields.	<i>Not Applicable</i>
Patient Registry ID	eOutcome.04	The ID or Number of the external report or record in eOutcome.03.	ID/number of the patient's record in an applicable patient registry (e.g. stroke, STEMI, trauma, etc).	Optional
Medical Record Number	eOutcome.04	The ID or Number of the external report or record in eOutcome.03.	ID/number of the patient's recorded medical history.	<i>TBD</i>
Encounter Number	eOutcome.04	The ID or Number of the external report or record in eOutcome.03.	ID/number of the patient's documented care episode.	<i>TBD</i>
Emergency Department Chief Complaint	eOutcome.06	The patient's reason for seeking care or attention, expressed in the terms as close as possible to those used by the patient or responsible informant.	Short statement, max of 100 characters.	Optional
Emergency Department First SBP	eOutcome.07	The first recorded Emergency Department Systolic Blood Pressure.	Numerical values only.	Optional
Emergency Department Procedures	eOutcome.09	The procedures performed on the patient during the emergency department visit.	All pertinent Emergency Department procedures that provide clinically relevant feedback to the EMS provider.	<i>TBD</i>
Emergency Department Diagnosis	eOutcome.10	The practitioner's description of the condition or problem for which Emergency Department services were provided.	All pertinent Emergency Department diagnoses that provide clinically relevant feedback to the EMS provider.	Required



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Date/Time of Hospital Admission	eOutcome.11	The date and time the patient was admitted to the hospital. <i>NOT the date/time of ED admission.</i>	Applies to in-patient or observation admissions. Should generally match with the date/time the patient left the ED.	Required
Hospital Procedures	eOutcome.12	Hospital Procedures performed on the patient during the hospital admission.	All pertinent in-patient or observation procedures that provide clinically relevant feedback to the EMS provider.	<i>TBD</i>
Hospital Diagnosis	eOutcome.13	The hospital diagnosis of the patient associated with the hospital admission.	All pertinent in-patient or observation diagnoses that provide clinically relevant feedback to the EMS provider.	Required
Total ICU Length of Stay	eOutcome.14	The total number of patient days in any ICU (including all ICU episodes).	Day = in ICU over midnight	Optional
Total Ventilator Days	eOutcome.15	The total number of patient days spend on a mechanical ventilator (excluding time in the operating room).	Day = on ventilator over midnight	Optional
Date/Time of Hospital Discharge	eOutcome.16	The date the patient was discharged from the hospital.	Hospital here is defined generally and includes ED, in-patient and observation. Applies to all patients.	Required
Hospital Discharge Summary	itOutcome.024	<i>Custom OC-MEDS Element</i>	Additional pertinent feedback or detail on the patient's outcome.	Optional
Patient Care Registry	eOther.02	An indication if the patient may meet the entry criteria for an injury or illness specific registry.	If the patient/care episode is not pertinent this field may be left blank.	<i>TBD</i>
Date/Time Emergency Department Admission	eOutcome.18	The date and time the patient was admitted to the emergency department.	Not present in OC-MEDS Hospital Hub. May refer to Date/Time of Transfer of Care (eTimes.12)	<i>Not Applicable</i>
