Reporting Methods for COVID-19 Antigen and Point of Care

Testing Reporting Entities should report results within 24 hours

Orange County Health Care Agency will accept the following two reporting methods for COVID-19 antigen and Point of Care Testing facilities.

- 1) Reporters with very limited and infrequent testing can fax a <u>COVID-19 Confidential Morbidity</u> Report (CMR) with a copy of the lab report if available to (714) 564-4050.
- 2) Reporters with higher volumes and regular testing should enroll for the Calredie Manual Lab Reporting Module (CMLRM). Each User who will be reporting results must complete this form.

Steps to Report via CalREDIE MLRM:

- 1. Complete the CalREDIE Manual Lab Reporting Account Request Form.
- 2. Submit completed account forms to <a href="mailto:calrediehelp@cdph.ca.gov">calrediehelp@cdph.ca.gov</a>
- 3. CalREDIE Helpdesk will process the application and send the applicant their login credentials.
- Each user should review the Quick Start Manual Guide: <u>Manual Lab Reporting</u> <u>Quick Start Guide</u>. This documents describes how to log in and submit a result.

They should be able to login to the CalREDIE MLRM and begin submitting results once they have their account login credentials.
