		<ul> <li>Continued support of vaccine PODs and very busy with current surge.</li> </ul>
		<ul> <li>No longer have BiNax Now. PCR test kits are available and Care Start Antigen</li> </ul>
		tests available.
		<ul> <li>Regen and Bam are going to be stopped shipping out by federal government</li> </ul>
		and they are not recommended for use. Oral therapeutics have barely been
		giving an EUA, state controls distribution and mainly to large chain pharmacies.
