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Microsoft Teams **OCHCA** Update **COVID** Response 2 Case rates are continuing to decrease, 6.8 cases per 100,000. Dr. Grewal Hospitalizations are down to 160, down to baseline prior to surge. Report 29 ICU admissions, 1 pediatric. All over improving trends. Diversion is about standard, ambulance patient off load times also standard. BA1 is still the most prominent variant. Only 4 hospitalizations for flu in the county, 1 in ICU AOP is still activated supporting mobile pod vaccination center. Volumes coming down of use. Binex now and iHealth kits are still available, please contact county for supply. UCI has offered 75k sanitizer bottles for donations. Trauma grand rounds on March 3oth from 9am-11am.
