0	USAF TRANSCOM regulates pts to the Patient Reception Area	
0	Pt's transported by Plane, Ambulance, water borne asset	
0	FCC coordinates distribution and facilitates tracking locally.	
0	The FCC and County EMS assign patients to civilian hospitals according to	
	the bed report	
0	Transportation assets are staged at the Patient Reception Site (PRS)	
0	Patients arrive at PRS and are transferred directly to the treatment

0	Patient updates are provided daily to the FCC/HHS	
0	Upon discharge from the hospital, HHS will arrange follow-on care &
