2	OCHCA Update - Dr. Grewal Report	 COVID Response Case rates are continuing to decrease, 3.4 cases per 100,000. Have seen no upticks since the peak in Mid- January. Positivity rate down to 1.7% Hospitalizations are down to an average of 125 24 ICU admissions. All over improving trends. Diversion is about stabilized, ambulance patient off load times also stabilized. BA1 is still the most prominent variant. BA2 variant has increased to 28% of infections but overall cases are still low. Only 4 hospitalizations for flu in the county, 1 in ICU. A small uptick but nothing to be overly concerned about. AOP is still activated supporting mobile pod vaccination center. Volumes coming down of use. BinaxNOW and iHealth kits are still available and available for broader use outside of healthcare workers, please contact county for supply.
