- Currently 31 Covid pts, 14 of those are on vents.
- ICU is at full capacity with 12 of those being covid patients.
- 12 patients holding in ED waiting for a bed
- Having less compliant individuals each day at screening stations regarding visitors providing proof of vaccine or negative covid test in the last 72 hours
- Lot of concerns with staff not vaccinated/uploading their exemption, especially with the upcoming Sep 30th deadline.

- ICU at 50% capacity, 1 COVID patient
- Process in place to test visitors and vendors.
- Staff nearly compliments
