2	OCHCA Update - Dr. Grewal Report	<ul> <li>COVID Response</li> <li>Case rates are increasing, over 18 cases per 100,000. Small steady increase</li> <li>Positivity rate is up as well</li> <li>Hospitalizations are not as very high, but hospitalization have doubled since last meeting, but not ICU patients has been a slower increase.</li> <li>BA2.12.1 is still the most prominent variant, it appears to be more infectious.</li> <li>Sporadic cases for flu in the county. A small uptick but nothing to be overly concerned about. Positivity has gone up significantly statewide.</li> <li>AOC is still activated supporting mobile pod vaccination center. Focusing on the equity zip codes in Orange County.</li> <li>BinaxNOW kits are still available and available for healthcare workers, please contact county for supply.</li> <li>Over the counter kits are also available but being reserved for individuals without easy access.</li> <li>No major updates on therapeutic approach except that public health is dealing with allocations.</li> <li>Booster shot authorized for children 5 and up</li> </ul>
