2	OCHCA Update - Dr. Grewal Report	<p>COVID Response</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Case rates are increasing, over 18 cases per 100,000. Small steady increase - Positivity rate is up as well - Hospitalizations are not as very high, but hospitalization have doubled since last meeting, but not ICU patients has been a slower increase. - BA2.12.1 is still the most prominent variant, it appears to be more infectious. - Sporadic cases for flu in the county. A small uptick but nothing to be overly concerned about. Positivity has gone up significantly statewide. - AOC is still activated supporting mobile pod vaccination center. Focusing on the equity zip codes in Orange County. - BinaxNOW kits are still available and available for healthcare workers, please contact county for supply. - Over the counter kits are also available but being reserved for individuals without easy access. - No major updates on therapeutic approach except that public health is dealing with allocations. - Booster shot authorized for children 5 and up



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		<p>OCHCA</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Last week was the deadline for application cycle for the HPP grant to provide support over the next five years and was submitted on time. - Please let Kevin C. know what hospitals are interested in ICS disaster management training class. - Ongoing Conex project so far has been a phenomenal effort led by Eddie Morales. Completed about half of the hospitals thus far. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Been able to ensure all items are still usable and align purchases with needs. - Training calendar has been sent out, location at Environmental Health Site, 55 and Dyer Rd. with free parking. Classes include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Situation Awareness o ICS overview o Hazard Vulnerability Analysis o Emergency Preparedness for Home and Office o Continuity of operations o Leadership - Radiation and chemical surge plan have been created; the county reached out to hospitals to gather information on each hospitals capabilities. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Chris R. has a zebra handbook from the LA county website, please contact him for a copy. o County is creating a list of additional trainings to be conducted and will include Decon as requested by the hospitals. - The state is no planning on holding any drills this year, moved to 2023. County will facilitate a drill again after the new employees are in boarded.

Joint Commission coming to present on new standards. - The team is working at every level including the President to obtain contrast media, production has increased, no timeline on supplies specifically. - Contact Mary for HICS training, 4 hour session and includes table top exercise for facility staff.

The team have been setting up the 15 til' 50 surge plan twice a day during shift change every day. The team has dramatically improved and set up the fundamental structure just over 3 minutes. <p>UCI</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- 5 COVID patients, 1 ICU- Decommissioned drive through tents- Working through completing an after-action report and bringing in a consultant.- Conducted a cyber security exercise with IT team.- Working on business continuity plans with tier 1 departments. <p>OCIAC</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Missing person BOLO sent out, please review and keep vigilant for that patient.- Working to coordinate additional training for Active Shooters. Working with DHS and FBI, more details to come.- Please invite Steve to any facility drills as a learning opportunity.- Please send Suspicious Activity or threats reports to OCIAC for assistance and just to provide awareness to be shared with other institutions.
