| <p>2</p> | <p>OCHCA Update - Dr. Grewal Report</p> | <p>COVID Response</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Case rates are increasing, 5.7 cases per 100,000. Small steady increase but nothing alarming - Positivity rate down to 1.9% - Hospitalizations are down to an average of 66 - 13 ICU admissions. - All over improving trends. - Diversion is about stabilized, ambulance patient off load times also stabilized. - BA2 is still the most prominent variant, about 85% of cases in the area. - Sporadic cases for flu in the county. A small uptick but nothing to be overly concerned about. - AOC is still activated supporting mobile pod vaccination center. Focusing on the equity zip codes in Orange County, 2 in Santa Ana, 1 Garden Grove and 1 in Anaheim. - BinaxNOW kits are still available and available for healthcare workers, please contact county for supply. - No major updates on therapeutic approach except that relative supply has expanded. <p>OCHCA</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Kevin is working to expand coalition including Dialysis, Home Health and Hospice, Outpatient Surgery and Long-Term Care Facilities. |
