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<p>2</p>	<p>OCHCA Update</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Dr. Grewal Report - Kevin Chao 	<p>COVID Response</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Decreasing case rates, nearing where we were a week ago, seems to be leveling off. Still significantly higher than a month ago. - Positivity rate at 27.4%. - Hospitalization seems to be leveling off, staying at about 1200 over last few days. Hoping to see a little bit of a decrease according to some models. - Pediatric admission as a percentage are higher than traditionally, at around 8%. - Omnicom is most dominate variant. - Low influenza case rates only 7 needing to be hospitalized last week. - Nearly no diversion times because it is suspended currently. Not planning to lift until case rates lower - APOTs tend to be around 40 minutes, also flattening out. - Seeing less ERCs with delays in extended APOTs. - Staffing program is still in place, some facilities ask for staff but decline prior to signing MOU - EOC is still busy supporting vaccination pods - No more Bia Nix now, giving allocation to SNFs for visitors only. Have a few Care Start antigen test. - Received a supply of iHealth tests, only received 11,000 for all Orange County healthcare workers. - Notified yesterday from State that we will be receiving allocation for test kits, unsure of quantity. - No updates on monoclonal antibodies, currently only Sotrovimab is effective on omicron variant. Very limited supply - UCI has over 20 patients unable to discharge or send to SNFs, really clogging up patient flow. Dr. Grewal mentioned to state but not yet received a response.
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		<p>Healthcare Agency</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Onboarding 2 interns and interviews begin next week for 3 full time county positions in emergency management. - Last year of 5-year grant cycle and working on renewing information. - Reaching out to hospitals to conduct a site visit and see inside Conex containers.

4	<p>All Facilities Status Updates</p>	<p>Hoag Newport/Hoag Irvine (via Teams chat)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Average of about 100 covid patients between both campuses. - Organization continues to test our non-vaccinated employees and now have started testing employees who have not got their booster shots. - We have suspended valet services and are currently back to virtual meetings. <p>St. Joseph's Health</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 120 COVID patients - staffing is a challenge - Open command center - 10 nurse and 8 CNAs received from CDPH with partial wavier of nurse ratios. <p>St. Jude Medical Center</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 84 COVID positive patients, 13 on vents, 14 in ICU, 10 in step down unit. - Onboarded 22 travelers, - Received iHealth test kits 1/19/22. <p>Mission Hospital (via email)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - COVID in house: 69 (decreasing!) - ED also saw decrease in daily patients the last 5 days



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		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Staffing still short (40 caregivers out, being monitored before return) - More travelers coming; Organizing volunteers and Cope Scholars to assist with non-nursing help in ED - Command Center call daily - Space and staffing plan assessed/updated daily <p>KPC Health (Orange County Global, South Coast Global, Chapman Global, Anaheim Global)</p> <p>Orange County Global</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 29 COVID positive patients, 3 holding in ER - 2 out of 3 surge tents activated - Uptick in census, creating struggle with staffing - Requesting waiver for staffing ratios nearly every day with no luck <p>Anaheim Global</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 8 positives, 3 in ICU with 2 on vents <p>Prime Health (La Palma Intercommunity Hospital, West Anaheim Medical Center, Huntington Beach Hospital, Garden Grove Hospital Medical Center)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Not present <p>Memorial Care (Orange Coast Memorial and Saddleback Memorial)</p> <p>Orange Coast</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 80 COVID positive, 6 hold in ER, 6 ICU - Testing material supply issue - Wanted to confirm that iHealth kits are for staff in isolation to return to work. Response received is yes. <p>Saddleback</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 46 COVID confirmed cases, 16 ICU, 8 vented
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		<ul style="list-style-type: none">- ED surge tent utilized- Providing vaccines 2 times a week. <p>Kaiser Permanente</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Command center still activated- 68 COVID positive Anaheim, 45 Irvine Hospital- Low Critical care unit census- Drive through testing is very busy, meeting capacity.- Surge tents still up- Staffing and travelers doing okay- Materials management watching regular supplies as struggling to obtain but well stocked on PPE. <p>Camp Pendleton Naval Hospital</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Not present <p>Foothill Regional Medical Center</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- High census, 19 COVID positive in house.- Screening process moved outdoors.- Challenges with staffing <p>Los Alamitos</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- 50-60 COVID patients- Staffing challenges- Struggling with normal supplies but covered in COVID supplies <p>Placentia Linda (via email)</p>
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		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - COVID cases have doubled in the last week and the hospital is full and holding patients in the ED - Put back up our Western Shelter Tent for ED Overflow - Our employees out with COVID were 28 last week and down to 10 this week. <p>Fountain Valley Regional</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 97 COVID patients - 3 outdoor tents - Staffing is a challenge, but a lot of Christmas and New Year illness are coming back to work. - Struggling with difficult patients. <p>AHMC Anaheim Regional Medical Center</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 49 positive patients, half in ICU, opened a new COVID unit 1/19/22 - Over 50 employees out sick - Cancel elective surgeries to offset staffing shortage. <p>CHOC</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 233 Census, ED average between 300-350 daily. - 32 COVID inpatient, 7 ICU - Challenge with staffing, 30 out just today. - Testing supplies dwindling fast with so many staff exposures - Working with DLS for support with testing, trying to find manageable process and location. - Struggling with meeting testing requirements for visitors as they are our patients' parent/caregiver/surrogate. - 675 day of command center activation.
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		<p>UCI</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- 106 inpatients positive, over 100 all week- Extremely busy in ED- Procured 20,000 at home test kits, sending one to each staff member for family use as a convenience.- Placed request from the county for staffing in ED, people arrived yesterday.- 679 staff members out as of Tuesday, coming down a little.- Working on getting staff COVID vaccine boosters. <p>OC Heart</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Not present
