- Over last 3 or 4 weeks, dropping in hospitalization consistently
- Case rates was 17 per 100k, peaked at 243 per 100k
- If you refer to old tiering structure, we would still be in the purple tier.
- Hospital diversion was at 32 hours which is a little high but returning to normal levels.
- Current hospitalizations show about 40% are admitted with COVID not for COVID.
 Although this makes no difference on hospital procedures and staffing but may affect care strategy.
- BA2 variant, not currently showing to be a big issue. Omnicom BA1 variant saturated infections making BA2 not as impactful
- Influenza was not impactful this season, minimal hospitalizations throughout the state and decreasing as well.
- AOC is still open and activated supporting mobile vaccination pods. The vaccination volume has decreased greatly but working on vulnerable populations to have access.
- 30-day PPE supply offering, program ending Monday 2/28.
- Test kits available and working on getting these out to vulnerable populations.
- Monoclonal antibodies and managed by the state and the county to set specific allocations.
- Dr. Grewal had received the AAR as surge was growing, he will review the document and provide the team with information.

OCHCA

- Kevin Chao and Eddie Morales have been visiting hospitals and evaluating Connex Containers. Team is identifying expiring goods, items needing replacing and container maintenance. This is an ongoing project.
- Team will reach out to schedule and are very mindful to not ask for too much of the hospital's time to accommodate.
