Behavioral Health Services (BHS) Director's Report – Jeff Nagel

Dr. Nagel took questions in reference to the Behavioral Health Services (BHS) update memo that was sent out to the board ahead of time. He highlighted that integration has been the theme at the state and local level. There have been a number of integration initiatives, including the integration of the MHB and the Alcohol and Drug Advisory Board (ADAB) that will soon take place in our County. BHS has submitted a draft of the bylaws to the Mental Health Ad Hoc for feedback and will be preparing an ASR soon to go before the Board of Supervisors for their approval. Moreover, Dr. Nagel highlighted the “Are opioids wrong for you” add campaign, this is a 30 seconds ad that has been circulating in magazines, cable channels and others. In addition, Behavioral Health Directors have been engaged with the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) and C-SAC, ensuring that we are protecting local control funds and promoting funding flexibility for Mental Health Services Act.

- Dr. Rose referenced the new Stigma Free OC cards and urged all to continue to pledge and encourage others to pledge as well. The current number is approximately 1,199 pledges, with 193 organizational pledges.

New Business:

- We will begin to hold meetings at a new location beginning in May of 2020. They will be held at the new BHS Training Center, located in Orange, CA.
- Geoffrey Henderson mentioned that Correctional Mental Health does not get as much attention and would like more attention brought to this area. We will ask BHS to include Correctional Mental Health in our updates and invite them to our meetings.
- ADAB members expressed their excitement to hear about so much BHS news.

Committee Reports:

- Request to add the following Ad Hoc Committees: Public Comment, Community Planning, Correctional Mental Health, and Pediatrics.
- Pediatrics Task Force: The taskforce met on February 14th, which focused their meeting on the development of a Mental Health Visit Summary Report. Its goal will be to have an informative report after their office visits.
- Finance Committee- Steve McNally reported on Governor Newsom's interest in reverting on the MHSA Reserve. He expressed concern over the MHSA unspent funds, in particular with \$2 million Prevention and Early Intervention and \$34 million in other MHSA components. Moreover, Los Angeles is working on adding more Board and Care facilities, we may want to make ourselves aware of these efforts.
