

SKILLED NURSING/ASSISTED LIVING/RESIDENTIAL CARE FACILITY STATUS


- Confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SNFs/ALFs: 175 (104 residents & 61 staff) *as of 0900 4/22/20*
 - Outbreaks: Anaheim Healthcare Center, Huntington Valley SNF
 - PH mobile teams are available to assist SNFs w/ specimen collection & testing if the SNF is unable to test symptomatic residents.
- Graph below comparing 2019 & 2020 EMS (non-9-1-1 & 9-1-1) calls to SNFs/Urgent Cares; for time period 4/9 – 4/21 calls up 13%.
