


SKILLED NURSING/ASSISTED LIVING/RESIDENTIAL CARE FACILITY STATUS

- On 5/2/20 White House announced that FEMA will coordinate 2 shipments totaling 14-day supply of PPE to more than 15k nursing homes in the US. 73 OC facilities have been identified to receive the first 7-day supply starting first week of May & and additional 7-day supply in early June.






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EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES STATUS (full reports on [EMS Website-Notifications Archive](#))

- 9-1-1 ambulance transport volume remains 25-30% below normal. Below is an illustration of the transports since 1/1/20.



- Non-emergency ambulance transports are beginning to trend upward and are now about 45% below their normal average.



- Ambulance Patient Offload Time (APOT) is defined as the time the ambulance arrives at the receiving destination (wheels stop) to the time that the ambulance crew physically transfers the patient to the ED gurney. Last 24 hours: **Current Average APOT is 9m14s / Current 90th Percentile APOT is 18m17s.**

Average Offload Time




90th Percentile Offload Time
