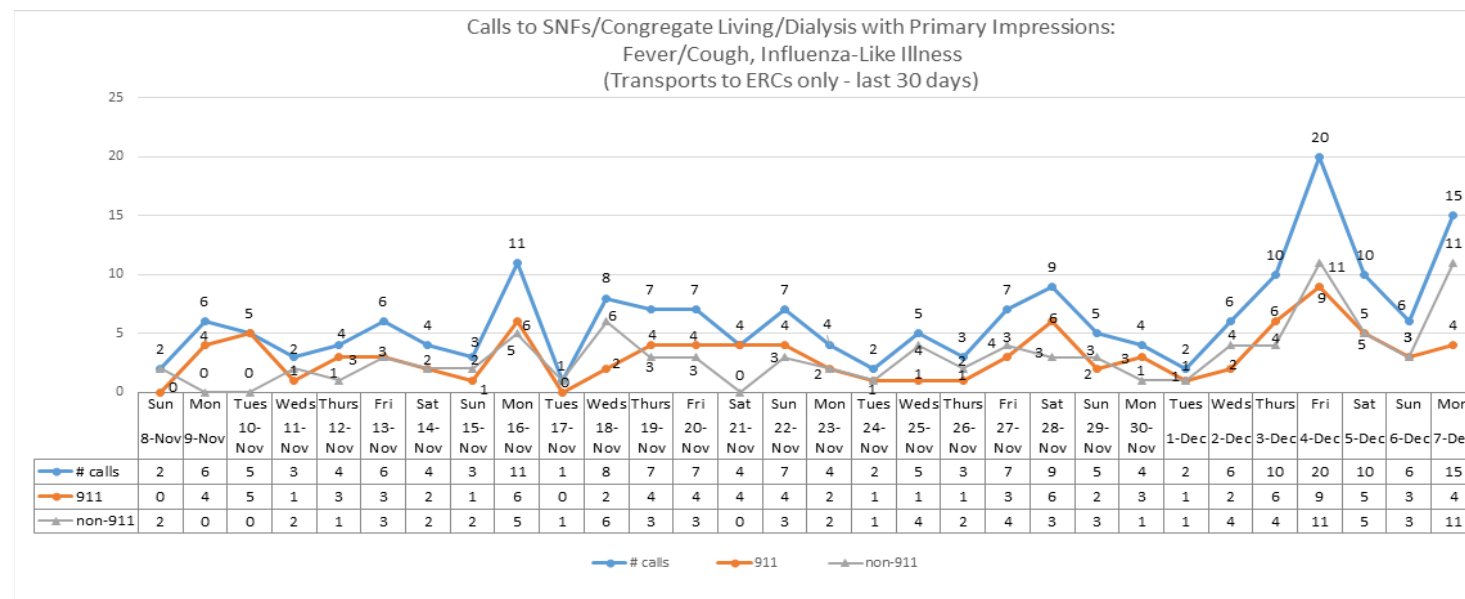

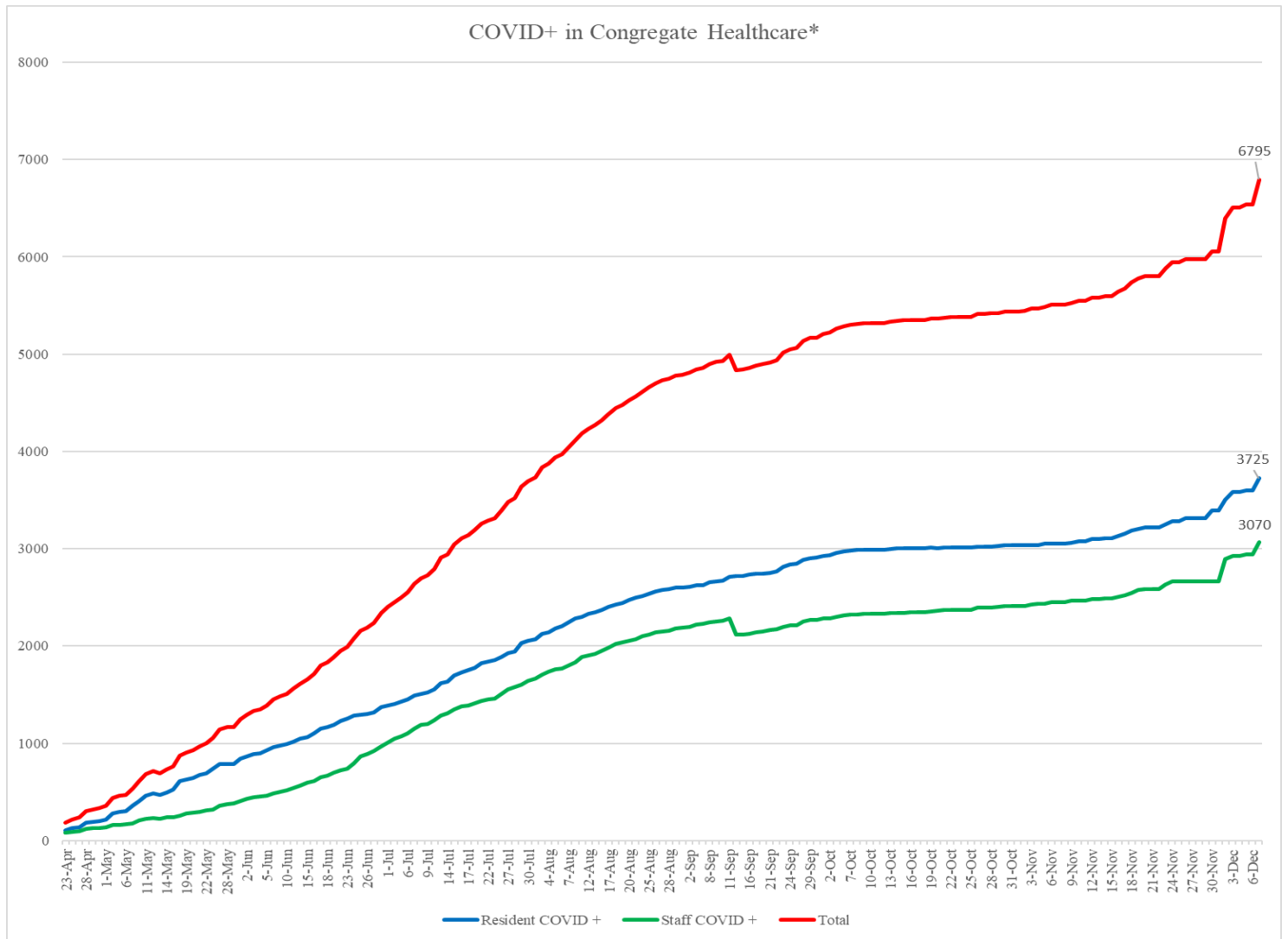

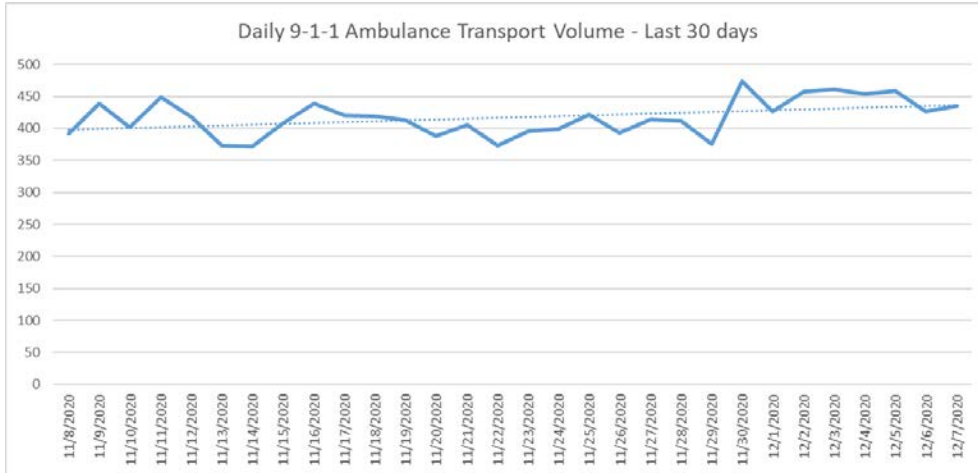

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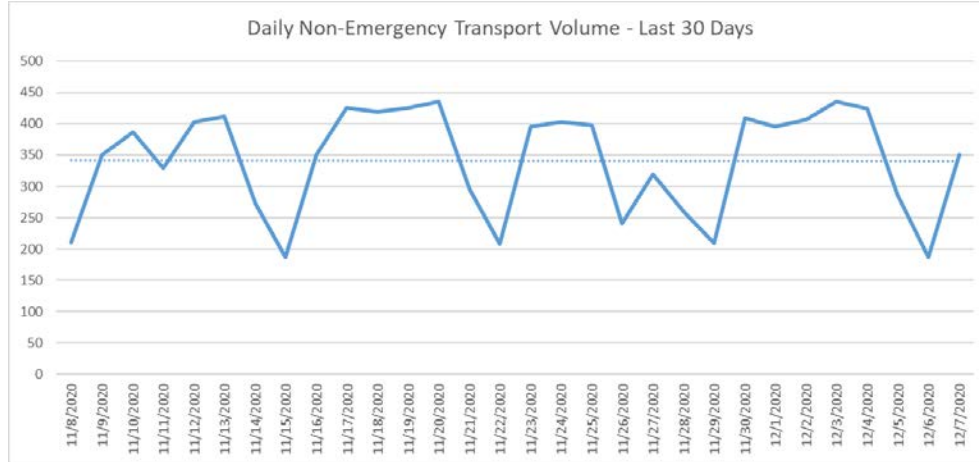

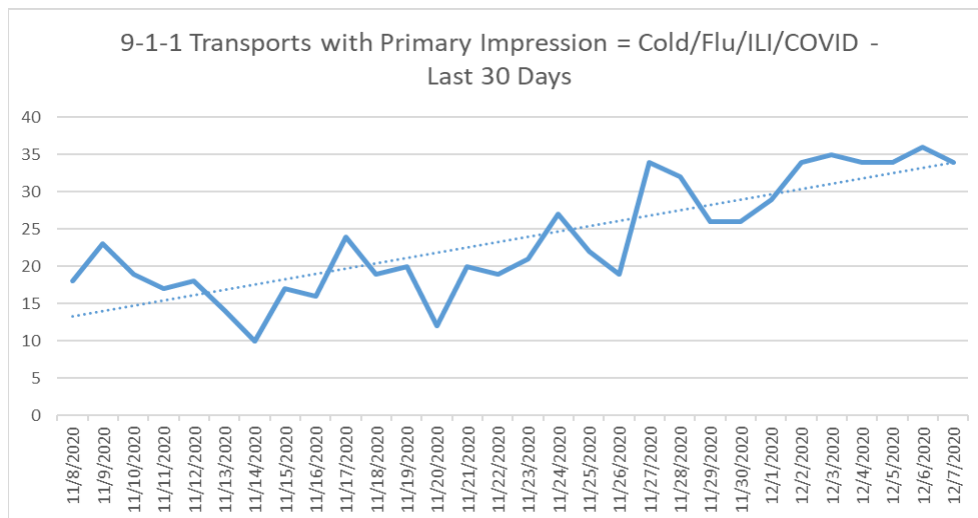
- 9-1-1 ambulance transport volume was higher the last several days and **are now trending upward** over the last 30 days. It is about **5% below normal** (pre-COVID) levels (Updated 12/08/20).



- Non-emergency ambulance transports have stabilized this week, but **continue to average about 15-20% below normal** (pre-COVID) levels overall (Updated 12/08/20).



- Primary Impressions of Cold/Flu/ILI by 9-1-1 EMS providers **continue to increase** (Updated 12/08/20).



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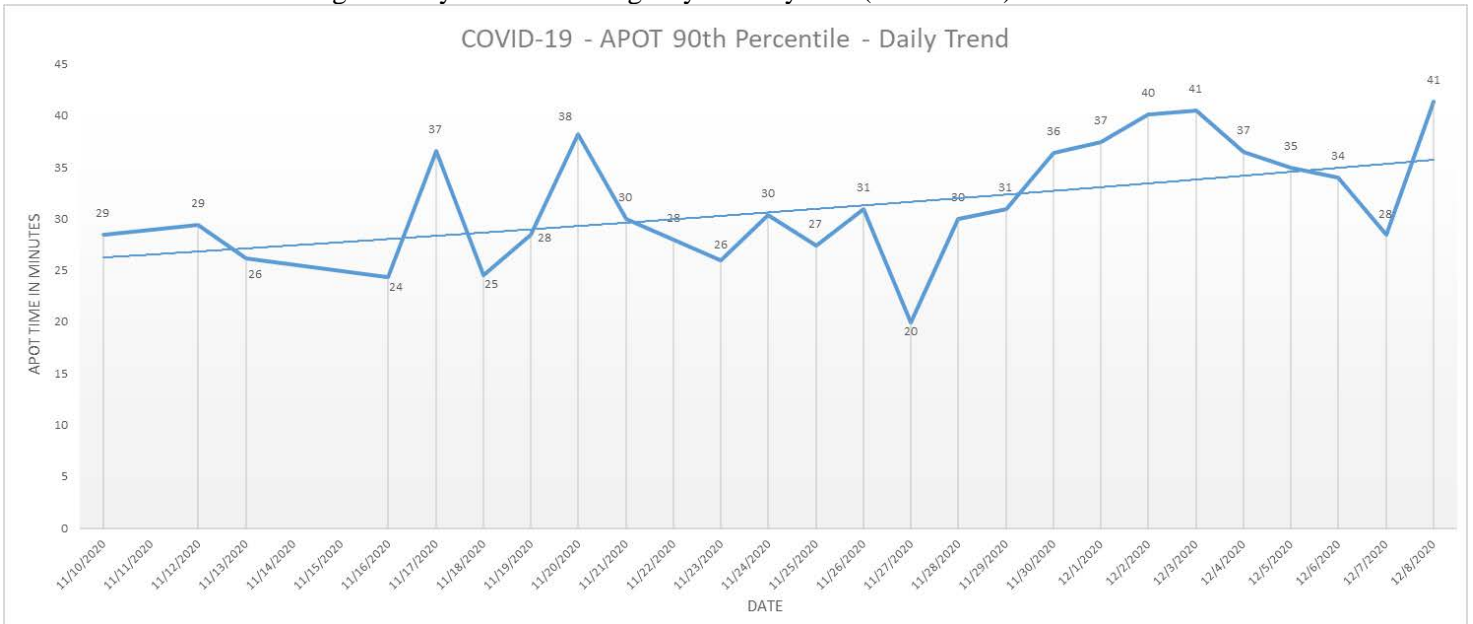
- Ambulance Patient Offload Time (APOT) is defined as the time the ambulance arrives at the receiving destination (wheels stop) to the time that the ambulance crew physically transfers the patient to the ED gurney. Last 24 hours: **Current Average APOT is: 18m30s / Current 90th Percentile APOT is: 41m41s**

The chart below displays a daily trend over the last 30 days.

- Seventeen (17) ERCs had APOT times greater than thirty (30) minutes.
- Five (5) ERC had APOT times greater than sixty (60) minutes.

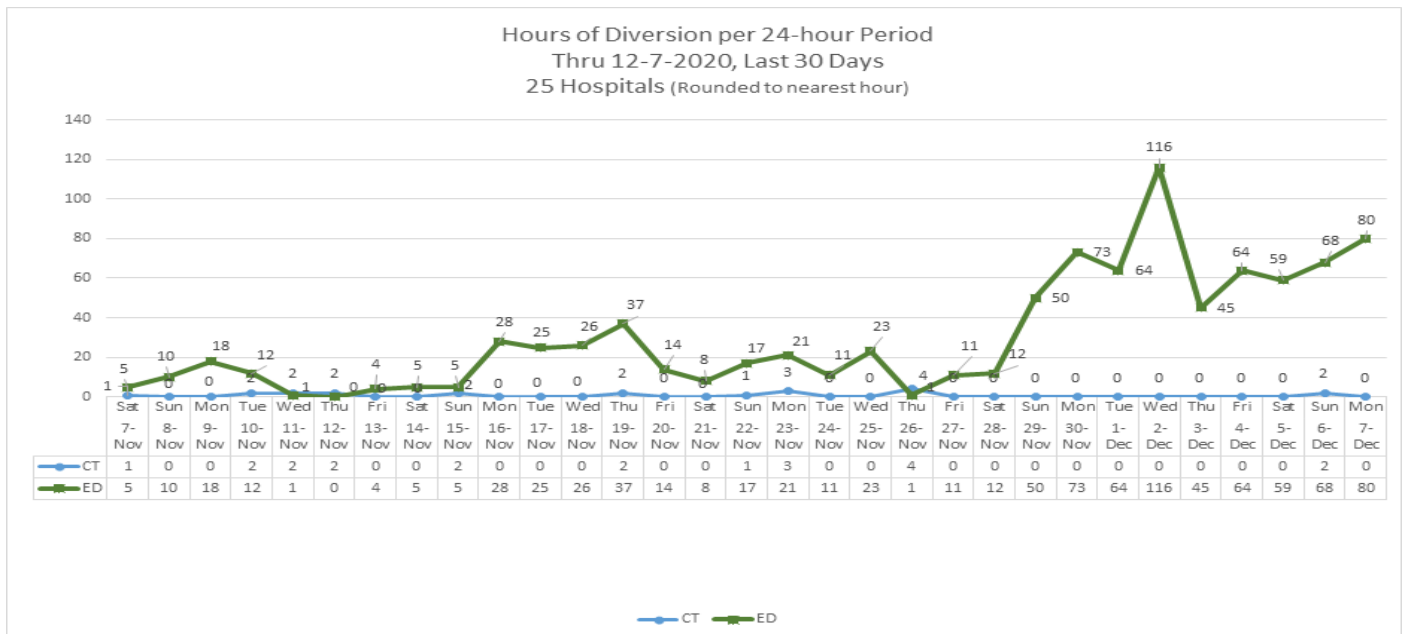

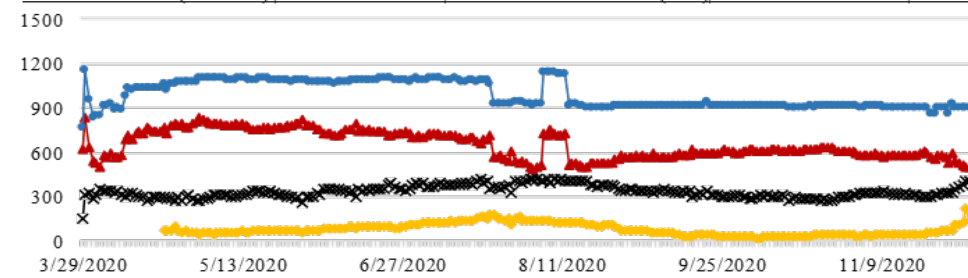

7-DAY HISTORY BED OCCUPANCY - (12/07/20) | IN-PATIENT BEDS-4072

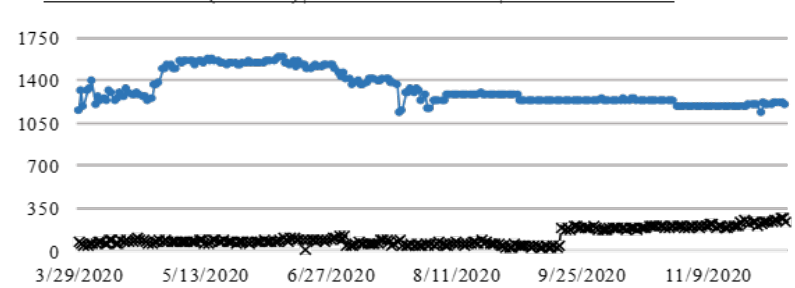

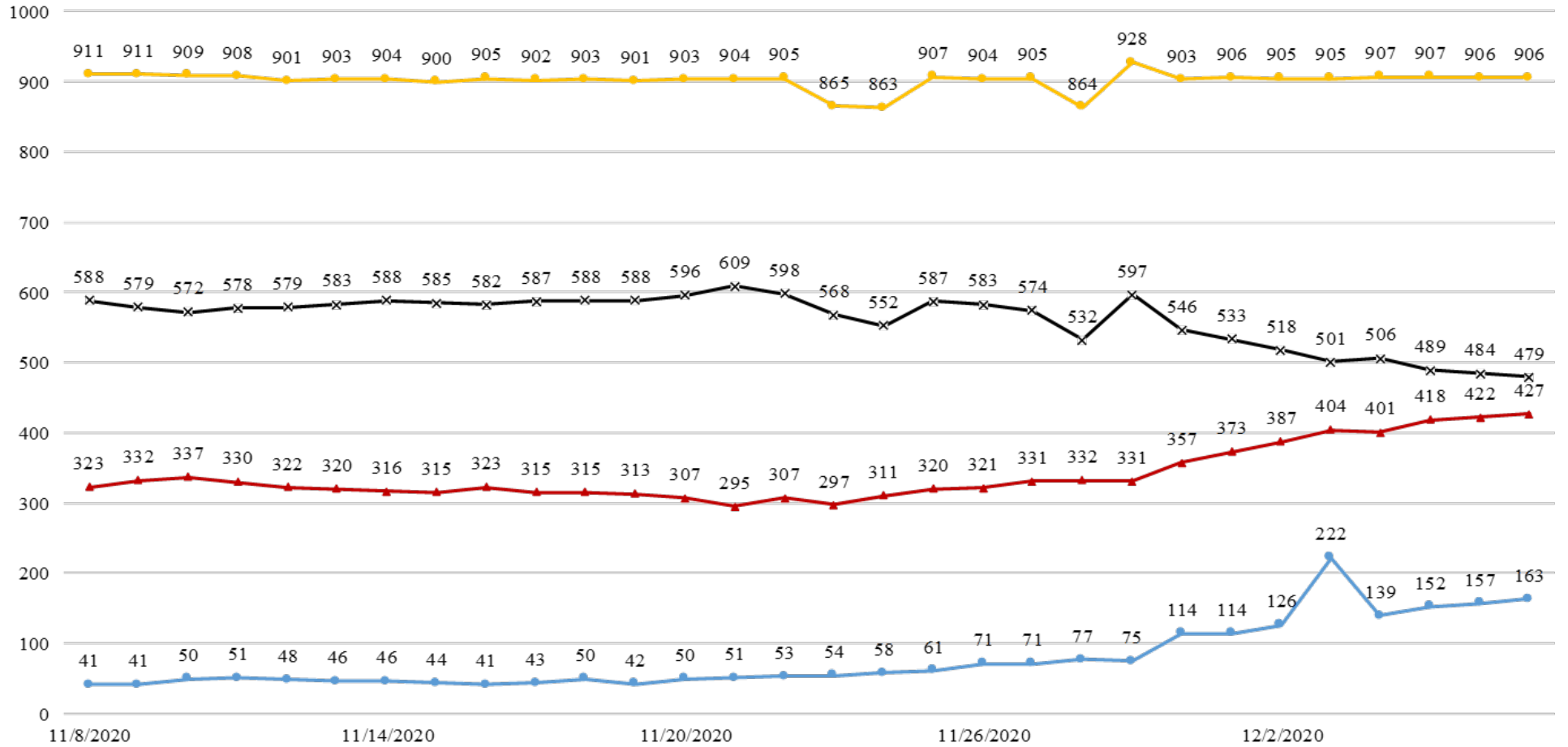
