SUBJECT: DOPAMINE MOVED TO OPTIONAL ALS INVENTORY ITEM DUE TO NATIONWIDE SHORTAGE

Due to a national shortage of supplies of dopamine, Orange County EMS has moved all dopamine formulations (vials, prefilled syringes, and premixed solutions) to optional inventory status for Orange County Advanced Life Support (ALS) providers. The shortage is expected to persist for an extensive period of time.
