SUMMARY REPORT APPLICATIONS FOR ORANGE COUNTY EMS FACILITY DESIGNATIONS JULY 14, 2015

The following hospitals have applied to Orange County Emergency Medical Services (OCEMS) for Emergency Receiving Center (ERC), Base Hospital (BH), Cardiovascular Receiving Center (CVRC), and Stroke Neurology Receiving Center (SNRC) re-designation. This report summarizes an OCEMS review of the application noting deficiencies, conditions and recommendations. Today, it is presented to the Facilities Advisory Committee for endorsement of their re-designation.

General Findings: Four facilities have satisfied criteria deficiencies identified during 2013 facility site surveys and currently meet the designation requirements for Emergency Receiving Center and Specialty Center designation when applicable. Endorsement considerations of designation are for a full three-year term or otherwise specified by committee.
