**SUBJECT:** Trafficking Victims Protection Act Compliance

**PURPOSE:**

To ensure compliance with requirements related to the Trafficking Victims Protection Act (TVPA).

**POLICY:**

All Behavioral Health Services (BHS) programs providing substance use disorder (SUD) treatment and prevention services shall be in compliance with the TVPA.

**SCOPE:**

County-operated and County-contracted SUD providers.

**REFERENCES:**

22 U.S. Code 7104

**PROCEDURE:**

- I. Contracts with SUD providers shall include a section that addresses compliance with TVPA requirements.
  - A. County-Provider contracts shall have procedures in place to address County-contracted SUD programs that are not in compliance with the TVPA.
- II. BHS managers providing oversight to County operated programs providing SUD services shall ensure compliance with TVPA requirements.
  - A. Instances of non-compliance with TVPA requirements shall be reported to the BHS Authority & Quality Improvement Services (AQIS) or to the Health Care Agency (HCA) Office of Compliance (OOC).
- III. AQIS shall include information on TVPA in the Annual Provider Training.
