Subject: Proposed Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Ground Emergency Ambulance Service Rates Adjustment

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In accordance with Orange County Emergency Medical Services Policy 715.00, *Orange County Ambulance Rules and Regulations Related to Ground Emergency Ambulance Service Rates Adjustment*, you are being notified of the proposed adjustment in the maximum allowable 911 emergency ground ambulance rate for Basic Life Support (BLS) services chargeable to a patient transported at the request of a public safety employee, by Orange County ambulance service providers for 2017.

The proposed rate increase (attachment) is based on the methodology used by the Board of Supervisors when rates were last adjusted on October 27, 2015. Specifically, the method calculates the percentage difference in the prior year's LA-Riverside-Orange County "all items" Consumer Price Index (CPI) rounded to the nearest tenth. The methodology also adjusts the maximum advanced life support (ALS) Paramedic Assessment and Transportation rate for Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) jurisdictional areas (excepting San Clemente, Westminster and Buena Park). The proposed rate increase is attached.

The rate adjustment has been placed on the April 7, 2017 EMCC agenda for review.
