

ORANGE COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES BASE HOSPITAL TREATMENT GUIDELINES VOMITING (ADULT/ADOLESCENT)

BASE GUIDELINES

- Determine ALS Standing Order treatments/procedures rendered prior to base hospital contact. Use ALS standing order as guidelines for treatments/procedures not initiated prior to base hospital contact.
- 2. Consider differential diagnosis as to the cause of the vomiting.
- 3. If continued signs of decreased tissue perfusion, continue 250 mL Normal Saline bolus and monitor for fluid overload.

ALS STANDING ORDER

- 1. If signs of dehydration or poor perfusion and lungs clear to auscultation (no evidence CHF):
 - Establish IV access and give 250 mL Normal Saline bolus, may repeat up to maximum 1 liter to maintain adequate perfusion.
- 2. For continuous nausea or vomiting, and not known or suspected to be pregnant, administer:
 - Ondansetron (Zofran™) 8 mg (two 4 mg ODT tablets) to dissolve orally inside of cheek as tolerated; OR,
 - 4 mg IV, may repeat 4 mg IV once after approximately 3 minutes for continued or recurrent nausea or vomiting.
- 3. Maintain airway, suction as necessary.
- 4. Transport to nearest appropriate ERC (ALS escort if fluids or medication required).
