This issue of the In+Care newsletter will review some of the major steps in the past (5) five years.

The newsletter began as a resource for providers serving people living with HIV (PLWH) in Orange County. Since the first issue, the newsletters focused on letting people in the community know about key issues relating to HIV care in Orange County. These newsletters have helped PLWH and their providers stay up to date on services in Orange County.

Many things have changed in the HIV community since 2012 that have improved the lives for PLWH in Orange County. See below for a summary of some of the successes in the past five (5) years.

The HIV Planning Council continues to allocate over **\$6 million dollars** toward needed HIV services.



Increased the number of people living with HIV who are virally suppressed.

In 2012, 40% of PLWH were virally suppressed. In 2017, 60% of PLWH are virally suppressed.



As of September 2017, a total of **1,108** clients have moved out of Ryan White medical care because of insurance provided by the **Affordable Care Act (ACA)**.

Orange County Successes from 2012-2017



In 2015, **PrEP services** started in Orange County to help prevent new HIV infections.

Increased number of people living with HIV who know their status.

In 2012, it was estimated that only 80% of PLWH knew their status. In 2017, it is estimated that 91% of PLWH know their HIV status.



The **National HIV/AIDS Strategy** was updated in **2015** to lead a national effort to reduce HIV infections and improve care for people living with HIV.
