Furthermore, he suggested we look into Los Angeles County's MHSAs budgets and see how they are working their around in providing funding for Board and Cares.
- Helen Cameron-
 - Ms. Cameron provided information on a program called Head Space, located all over the country of Australia. This program is an early intervention program for people with their first psychotic break.

will be Prevention and Early Intervention community meetings coming soon at the Delhi Center, where the community and providers can participate in the planning of additional preventative care services. In addition, there will be an MHSA Public Forum on Jul 16th, at Delhi in Santa Ana.

- Sandy Finestone expressed concern over the tracking of program outcomes and would like to set up a meeting with program soon to provide insight on the effectiveness of the programs and tracking of outcomes.
- CALMHB/C-
 - Alisa Chatprapachai reported that they received a training on behavioral health disaster management.
