#### **Open MHSA Public Hearing**

- Opening Remarks and Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) Program Amendments Overview: Dr. Bhuvana Rao
  - Dr. Rao thanked the guests in attendance and the members of the Mental Health Board. She provided an overview of the PEI amendments to the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Three- Year Program and Expenditure Plan for Fiscal Year (FY) 18/19- 19/20. Two of the PEI amendments were presented and approved at the MHSA Steering Committee on April 30, 2018, School Readiness/ Connect the Tots for an expansion of \$600,000 annually and School-Based Behavioral Health Intervention services for an expansion of \$1,600,000 annually. The third amendment School-Based Violence Prevention Education Program was expanded as directed by the Board of Supervisors (BOS) to include a new Threat Assessment/ Active Shooter violence prevention and response training program component to existing services for an additional \$247,000 annually. Dr. Rao indicated that no public comments were received during the 30-day public comment period for the plan.
