

Ebola – 2014 Archived Materials

The West African Ebola Epidemic in 2014-2016 was the largest Ebola outbreak in history and was centered in Guinea, Liberia, and Sierra Leone. 28,610 cases were reported from West Africa with 11,308 (39%) deaths. Cases were exported to several other countries, including four in the United States. Eleven people were treated for EVD in the U.S., of whom two died.
