3	CHA Update - Mary Massey	Not present Had anyone received new mandate (non-AFL) regarding testing visitors. - St. Joes has received it and doing best with long turnaround times.



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<p>3</p>	<p>OCHCA Update</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Dr. Grewal Report - Kevin Chao 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Case rates have upward trend in hospitalizations over past few days. In purple tier range, diversion times still high through December. - About 80% of cases are Omnicom variant. Not recommending certain monoclonal antibodies that are ineffective to this strain. - Higher positivity rate than last years surge but lower ICU inpatients. - Suspended hospital diversions on 12/30/21 due to APOTs being well above standard times. - Only a handful of flu and ‘flurona’ cases inpatient. - Staffing shortages <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o EMS Authority has staff available but at a cost. Facilities must send a resources request and it gets sent to the state. - AOC activated, not accepting resource requests with few exceptions for available supplies such as test kits, extra N95 masks and some cleaning supplies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Staffing requests can be made through the EMS Duty Officer. - Continued support of vaccine PODs and very busy with current surge. - No longer have BiNax Now. PCR test kits are available and Care Start Antigen tests available. - Regen and Bam are going to be stopped shipping out by federal government and they are not recommended for use. Oral therapeutics have barely been giving an EUA, state controls distribution and mainly to large chain pharmacies. - Kevin Chao or Eddie Morales will be contacting the hospitals to look at the Conex containers. - How is HCCOC supporting testing requirements? Unfortunately, a free for all due to limited supply. County has contracted with Diagnostic Laboratory Science and able to set up testing programs on site for free. - Any discussion of how to manage less acute homeless patients? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Go to reach out to the state to support, need a way to move these patients out of hospitals, main issue is staffing.
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		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - OC Global sent staffing ratio to the state and was denied. Any hospitals with same issue? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o UCI reports taking multiple measures to avoid going out of ratio.
4	<p>All Facilities Status Updates</p>	<p>Hoag Newport/Hoag Irvine</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Not present <p>St. Joseph Health (St. Joseph's Hospital)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Rise in covid numbers, 70 patients, lower acute - Concern with staffing, with upset caregivers unable to access tests. <p>St. Jude Medical Center (via Teams chat)</p> <p>St Jude currently have 63 COVID PT, 7 which is on vents, 9 of those in SDU, 7 is in ICU. Emergency department is being overrun with patients, a great majority of which is COVID related. Of course, like every other facility, staffing is an issue across the board.</p> <p>Mission Hospital</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Struggling with staffing and following different rules depending on vaccination status. - Maybe open booster clinic on site for staff. <p>KPC Health (Orange County Global, South Coast Global, Chapman Global, Anaheim Global)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - OC Global 33 Inpatient, lower acuity - Anaheim Global has 9 inpatients - Both locations have surge tents deployed
