- Dr. Michele Cheung welcomed all in attendance.
- Meeting highlights from 4/12/22 approved by the council.

- Staffing updates were provided.

Updates and Announcements:

- Formula updates - Available on OCHCA website. Things have been quieting down since the US has been receiving deliveries from other countries. Per Liza Scammahorn, HCA WIC has not been receiving many calls about the availability of formula. Neighborhood stores all seem to have some type of formula available.
- Covid-19 updates – Vaccines available for all between 6 months old and older. Parents can go to Myturn.ca.gov, Vaccines.gov, or Othena.com.
- Monkeypox updates – Briefly went over how it spread. It was reported that Orange County has had a few cases. CDCD is following up on those cases and contacts.
- Arissa Palmer announced the upcoming BreastfeedLA events in July and August and provided the registration links.
- Nurse Family Partnership®: Supervising Public Health Nurses, Marcia Salomon and Robyn Baran, presented updates and outreach (national outcomes, local data, program elements, and recruitment brainstorming). Members viewed a brief video about NFP. Key goals: Improve pregnancy outcomes, improve child health and development and improve economic self-sufficiency of the family. Program encompasses the 1000 days from pregnancy to age two.
