WIC Eligibility

Families with low to moderate income levels and/or migrants may qualify.

Applicants can participate if they:

1. Meet one of the following requirements:
 - ◆ Pregnant
 - ◆ Breastfeeding a baby up to 12 months of age
 - ◆ Had a baby or were pregnant within the past 6 months
 - ◆ Have children under 5 years of age
2. Reside in California.

WIC Income Guidelines

Number of Persons in Family Unit	Annual (Before Tax)
2	\$37,814
3	\$47,767
4	\$57,720
5	\$67,673

April 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025

Income guidelines change annually.

Unborn children are counted in family total.

Those who receive Medi-Cal, CalFresh or CalWORKS, are income eligible for WIC.
