Discussions are being made internally with providers who are losing funding or that will not continue with their contract, those discussions are being held privately and not publicly. Linda Smith urges HCA to include BHAB in the front end of those decisions with regard to funding or programs cuts. Alan asked to be made aware of the decisions being made with programing, this would allow the BHAB to better advise HCA. Alan also mentioned he would like for the BHAB to be included and advised as programs are being notified of those cuts and changes to their contracts. Michelle would like to meet with Alan and Ian and discuss what this would like in including BHAB in these discussions. Alan suggested tightening up the confidentiality for BHAB members so that this allows for a bigger capacity in access to delicate information.

Michelle mentioned that during the FY 25/26 MHSA update, programs will be right sized in programing and budgets will be updated. Steve McNally asked for BHS to balance expectations. Linda Smith expressed concern with how the decision-making process is currently stated at with BHSA and the right sizing of programs. She stated BHAB is an advisory committee and is not being utilized properly by not advising prior to the decision making, rather being told after decisions have been set in stone.

Alan Albright asked that we have a calendar of what the planning is for the MHSA transition to BHSA. Karla will resend the 6-month overview that of what the current plan is for the Community Program Planning Process (CPPP). Alan questioned if there will be more public involvement beyond the PAC meetings; Michelle will provide those details at a later time.

Oversight and Accountability Committee (OAC) Meeting Dates: The OAC will meet next week for the Psychiatric Advance Directive (PAD) II and an extension of the CPPP. During the month of October, HCA will present the INN Pivot Project. There are multiple counties that are interested in opting in on the same pivot project. The OAC is interested in heling support this project and also including this in the BHSA.

Michelle reminded the BHAB that September is Recovery Happens Month and Suicide Prevention Awareness Month. There will be various events throughout the month of September and the BHAB will get reminders for these events.

Steve asked Michelle for a quick overview of the MHSA department and their roles. Michelle provided a quick overview of her department and included staffing roles and responsibilities. Steve requested a copy of the BHS org chart be sent to the BHAB.

- In addition, the committee discussed other items that should be addressed and planned for in the coming months:
 - o Learning about what the BHAB can analyze- based on their purview.
 - Steve mentioned looking at framework, to include what BHS would like for the BHAB focus on.
 - Alan would like to schedule an executive committee meeting for August 28th following the General meeting. He also commented on how the BHAB can work together with HCA; emphasizing BHAB members should have better access to information than the public to be advise accordingly.
 - Alan summarized what the committees are currently working on, which will allow the board to identify needs and gaps in services and formulate recommendations.

• Areas of Focus for the BHAB Committee-

Alan reviewed the areas of focus for the BHAB Committees, which included the following:

Childrens and Youth Committee- Reviewing and evaluating findings around suicide rates.

Older Adults Committee- Monitor and advocate for the MHSA INN proposal project.

Adults Committee- Review and evaluate community awareness and ability to access services. SUD Committee- Will work on providing a focus area.
