What is CARE?

Care is a **civil court process** to:

- Focus counties and other local governments on serving persons with untreated schizophrenia spectrum or other psychotic disorders.
- Provide behavioral health and other essential resources and services.
- Protect self-determination and civil liberties by providing legal counsel and promoting supported decision making.
- Intervene sooner in the lives of those in need to provide support.

Respondent

The severe symptoms cause behaviors that



Who does this program serve?

- Adults, 18 years or older.
- Diagnosed with a Schizophrenia Spectrum and Other Psychotic Disorders.
- Currently experiencing behaviors & symptoms associated with severe mental illness (SMI).
- Not clinically stabilized in on-going voluntary treatment.
- Sample criteria:
 - Requires services & supports to prevent relapse or deterioration
 - Participation in CARE Plan or Agreement is the least restrictive alternative.



Who can petition?

Family/Home

- Persons with whom respondent resides.
- Spouse, parent, sibling, adult child, grandparents, or another individual in place of a parent.
- Respondent (i.e. self petition)

Community

- First responder (e.g., firefighter, paramedic, mobile crisis response, homeless outreach worker)
- Director of a Hospital, or designee, in which the respondent is hospitalized.
- Licensed behavioral health professional, or designee treating respondent for mental illness.
- Director of a public /charitable organization providing behavioral health services or whose institution respondent resides.



County

- County behavioral health director, or designee
- Public Guardian or designee.
- Director of adult protective services or designee.



Tribal Jurisdiction

- Director of a California Indian health services program, California tribal behavioral health department, or designee.
- Judge of a tribal court located in CA, or designee.


How to file a petition?



- Complete petition (<u>CARE-100</u>) remember to fill out <u>ALL</u> requested information.
- Additionally, provide the required documentation.
 - Completed Mental Health Declaration (<u>CARE-101</u>) from licensed behavioral health provider OR;
 - Evidence the respondent was detained for a minimum of TWO periods of intensive treatment (WIC 5250 holds), the most recent episode being within the last 60 days.

Public Defender

- Legal representation for client
- Advocates for client

Supporter

- Appointed by client
- Friend, family, provider, etc.
- Advocates for client's preferences


Roles and Responsibilities

For Service Providers

- Communication is Key
 - All updates need to be communicated to the HCA CARE Team as soon as possible
 - Examples: Client transfers, linkage, AWOLs
- Meeting Coordination and Attendance
 - HCA CARE Team for linkage
 - Case Management Conferences
 - HCA, PD, Supporter, Client

CARE PETITION AUTO-POPULATION PROCESS

Automated CARE Petition Link

- 1. Click "Start as a Guest"—agree to terms, in order to continue
- 2. On dropdown for "County where you will file the case:" select "Orange"
- 3. BEFORE continuing to questions, there is a dropdown at the top right titled "Courthouse where you will file the case:"
 - Choose location for filing (Costa Mesa Justice Complex, is where court is held)
- 4. Continue to answer all questions
 - If CARE is not appropriate for the client, the form will stop and provide that guidance, based on user inputs/answers
 - If CARE is appropriate, the automated form will get to the end and give the user an option to download/print.
- 5. The petition still has to be printed, signed, and submitted to the court
 - Link to electronically submit completed, signed, and scanned forms
 - Attach completed and scanned forms
 - Fill required fields and hit send
 - ***If court type is required, select "Probate" as court type
 - Link to locations where petitions can be filed in person
 - Five locations have Self-Help Centers
