1. CALL TO ORDER

4. OCEMS REPORT

Medical Director's Report by Carl Schultz, MD

Decision made to increase Ketamine dose to 10 mg to simplify administration.

Ongoing efforts to manage pediatric BPD patients in the emergency department, including process improvements and documentation cleanup, are expected to roll out in the next 1-2 weeks.

- **Health Disaster Preparedness Report** by Gagandeep Grewal, MD

Healthcare coalition meeting scheduled for October 23rd at the Marine Way campus, starting at 9:00 AM. Recent hospital incident command system and health disaster management trainings were held both received positive feedback and are planned to continue quarterly if resources allow. Collaboration with long-term care and skilled nursing facilities initiated, focusing on evacuation procedures in disasters, especially following the LA fires' concerns. Ongoing discussion about disaster funding grants, which are still unresolved after 10 years. Recent COVID surge appears to be declining, and flu vaccines remain required for healthcare workers, with COVID vaccines still recommended but not mandatory

- **Ambulance Patient Off-Load Time (APOT) Report and Hospital Diversion Report** by Gagandeep Grewal, MD

APOT and diversion numbers up to July show significant improvement; APOT now averaging 23-24 minutes countywide, down from post-COVID highs. Hospital and EMS collaboration noted as key to improvement despite higher emergency transport volumes. Diversion hours are slightly higher than usual but remain below set standards.

EMSA has introduced an APOT audit tool; hospitals can now contest reported times but are encouraged to do so only for substantial discrepancies, given the resource cost of disputes. Emphasis on accuracy and agreement in report sign-off between facilities and providers.

5. **EMCC ADVISORY SUBCOMMITTEE AND ADVISORY GROUP REPORTS**

- **Facilities Advisory Committee (FAC)** by Genise Silva, RN

Trauma care systems meeting set for December 2, 2025 from 9am-11am including multidisciplinary participation (fire, police, social work, etc.), to take place at CAS large conference room; location in Outlook invite to be updated.

- **County Prehospital Advisory Committee (CPAC)** by Genise Silva, RN

CHOC renamed to Rady Children's Hospital Orange County.

- **Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC)** by Matt Armstrong, SCAA

Transportation Advisory Committee meeting was canceled due to lack of agenda items.

6. **UNFINISHED BUSINESS** –

- *Carl Schultz, MD*, Triage to Alternate Destination project: State did not approve a five-year data handling waiver; CSUs must process electronic data, but there is time to implement.
- *Gagandeep Grewal, MD*, AB 40 (APOT Bill): Emergency regulations approved by the state; audit tool and meeting processes in place for facilities exceeding 30-minute APOT, but no major changes for Orange County procedures.

7. **NEW BUSINESS** – *Recommended Action: Approvals*

- **OC Global's SNRC** *Carl Schultz, MD*, OC Global Stroke Neuro Receiving Center designation remains under review; decision pending following hearing panel report.
- **Brea Fire Department Request for Permanent Activation**, *Kristen Karpow, RN.*, Brea Fire Department's request to upgrade a unit to paramedic status approved, formalizing a conditional upgrade already in place.

- **Kaiser Irvine Emergency Receiving Center Designation**, *Genise Silva, RN*. Kaiser Irvine granted three-year conditional Emergency Receiving Center designation pending corrective action for three identified deficiencies (APOT times, compliance, trauma evaluation policy).
