Dear Orange County EMS,

This letter serves as formal notification of a change in resource deployment within our department, in accordance with Orange County EMS policies and procedures. Effective May 2, 2026, at 0800, our Basic Life Support (BLS) ladder truck, currently assigned to Station 6, will be reassigned to Station 1. This unit will continue to operate as a non-transport BLS resource and will remain available for dispatch in accordance with established OCEMS guidelines.

In conjunction with this change, an Advanced Life Support (ALS) engine company will be placed in service at Station 6. This unit will function as an ALS first response resource, staffed and equipped in compliance with OCEMS requirements for ALS providers.

The following information is provided in accordance with OCEMS Policy 705.00 requirements:

- This change will enable an ALS engine response from each of our six stations, enhancing the level of service provided to our community.
- FE6 provides ALS service from Station 6, located at 2691 Rosecrans Avenue in Fullerton. FT1 provides BLS service from Station 1, located at 312 E. Commonwealth Avenue in Fullerton, where it is co-located with FE1, the ALS engine assigned to that station.
- This exceeds the Board of Supervisors recommendations in Resolution 79-240.
- This change is intended to reduce the workload on FE1 and reposition FT1 to a more centralized location within the city, thereby improving response times for truck-related calls. Additionally, the addition of FE6 will enhance ALS coverage in the Station 6 area and contribute to reduced response times for ALS-level incidents in that region.
- This is a permanent change that will take place on May 2, 2026.
- FT1 and FE6 will utilize and maintain telecommunications as specified by OCEMS.
- FE6 will maintain a drug and solution inventory and basic and ALS medical equipment and supplies as specified by OCEMS.
- There are no additional training needs due to utilizing existing OCEMS accredited paramedics to staff FE6.
